# 115 YEARS



Dear friends,

This year, Center for Transforming Lives celebrated our 115th year of disrupting the cycle of poverty for women and children in Tarrant County.

115 years! Can you believe it?!

To give you some perspective:

- *When we opened our doors, Fort Worth's streets were dust and bricks, and clogged with horses and carriages.*
- *Our first shelter residents were women and children, seeking safety after stepping off trains and into the wild west.*
- *In 1922, we were a founding member of the Community Chest, known today as United Way Tarrant County.*
- *CTL served Fort Worth in the pandemic of 1918 and the pandemic of 2020.*

Over the years, we've stayed true to our purpose while continuing to meet emerging needs of today's reality. Here are a few highlights of 2022:

- *Due to the growth of family homelessness and to align with our two-generation model, we repurposed two floors of our downtown Fort Worth building to shelter women with infants and toddlers.*
- *CTL operated early childhood education within 4 locations and six partner sites.*
- *Our Economic Mobility Services distributed \$1,405,113 in rent assistance to 194 families impacted by the pandemic.*
- *Today, CTL actively collaborates with more than 100 local organizations to increase community impact.*

I'm also proud to announce that this year Center for Transforming Lives achieved national level accreditation through Council on Accreditation. This independent assessment verifies that CTL meets the



highest level of quality standards for human services organizations across all programs and operations.

Because of friends like you, Center for Transforming Lives has thrived as an institution for well over a century and today continues to fulfill its mission of disrupting the cycle of poverty for women and their children. Who knows what changes tomorrow will bring? But if yesterday is any indication, we'll be ready.

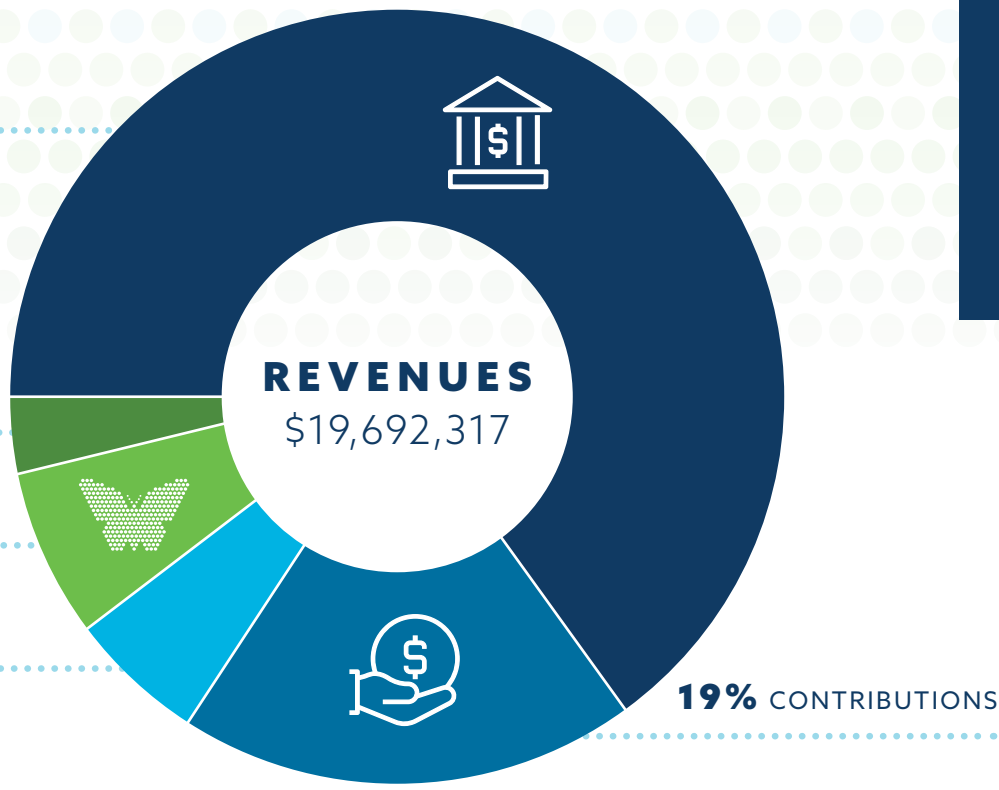

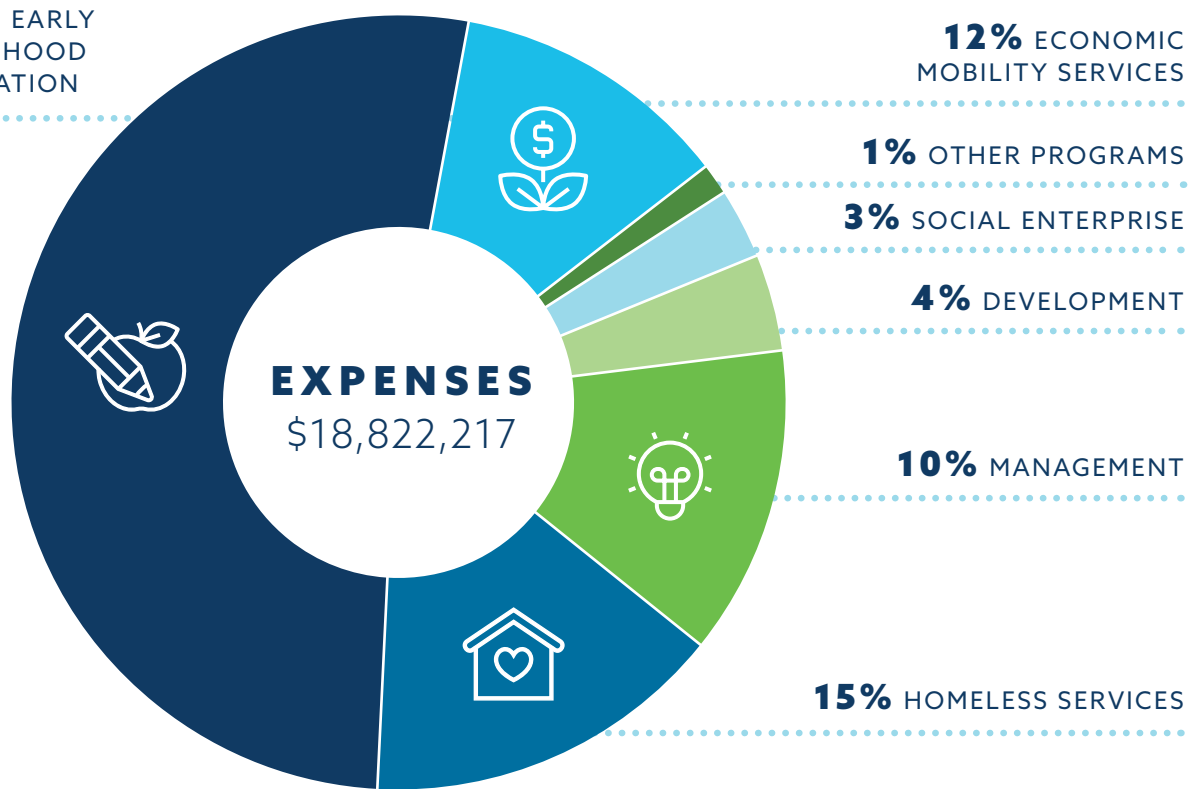

# Housing Services

Center for Transforming Lives offers three programs through Housing Services to provide women and their children safe housing and comprehensive support so they can establish emotional and financial stability. Programs include rapid rehousing, transitional housing, and an on-site emergency family shelter. Families are connected to additional services across the organization, including clinical counseling, early childhood education, and economic mobility services. The primary goal of Housing Services is to work side-by-side with women and their children to develop cycles of emotional and financial well-being. Using a trauma-informed, two-generation approach, Center for Transforming Lives provides families with intensive case management, housing search and placement, rental assistance, strengths and needs assessment, and service planning.

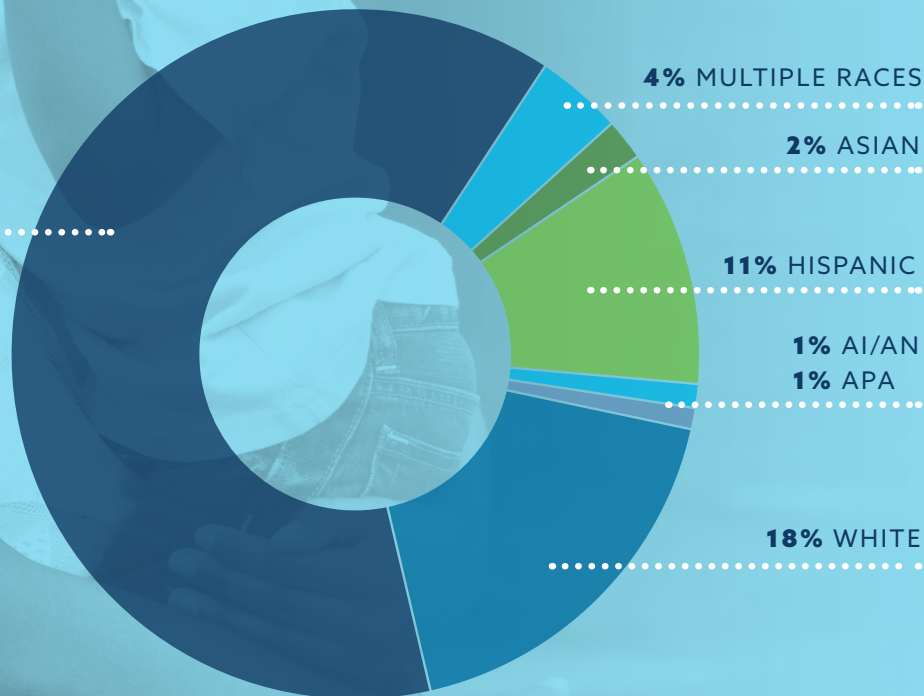

# Early Childhood Education

Education is the single most effective tool for breaking the generational hold of poverty - especially early childhood education (ECE). Center for Transforming Lives provides high-quality, affordable, year-round education at four child development centers and partners with other childcare centers throughout Tarrant County. As a Head Start and Early Head Start provider, Center for Transforming Lives can extend its reach to serve even more children and families living in poverty. Our Early Head Start program provides home visits to women from pregnancy through 6-weeks postpartum. Families receive prenatal education, support for a healthy pregnancy, and are encouraged to attend parent workshops and group sessions that provide pre-and postnatal resources and a sense of community. Our Head Start program provides literacy-rich, child-centered classrooms with low child-to-teacher ratios, individualized care, healthy daily meals, ample outdoor time, and social strengthening activities. Our dedicated teachers help children develop the social-emotional, cognitive, physical, and language skills they need for a successful transition to kindergarten. Because young children need nurturing, low-stress environments filled with language, learning, physical activity, and positive social interactions, all ECE classrooms are child-centered, with one-on-one attention and support given to each child.

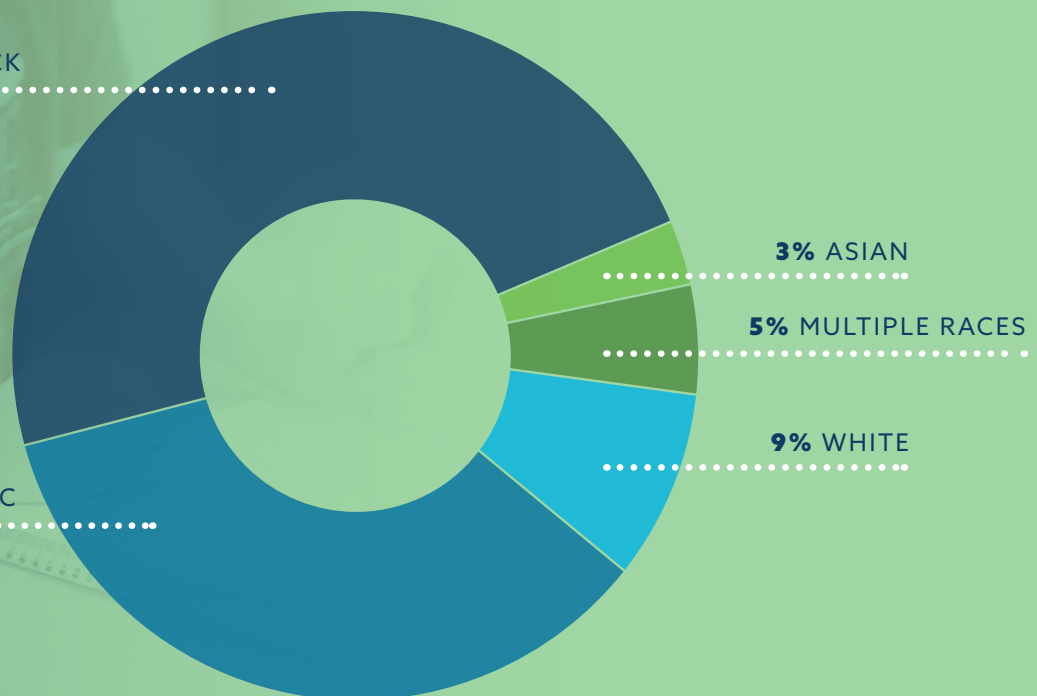

# Economic Mobility Services

Center for Transforming Lives' economic mobility services educate, coach, and engage women in asset-building services to create long-term financial independence and stability for their families. CTL's economic mobility services include group financial education, individual coaching, career readiness, and small business development resources. The program equips participants to operate a positive budget by increasing income, savings, and credit scores while decreasing debt. CTL also offered rent assistance as part of its Covid Relief programming, enabling families to remain in their homes despite pandemic-related income interruption.

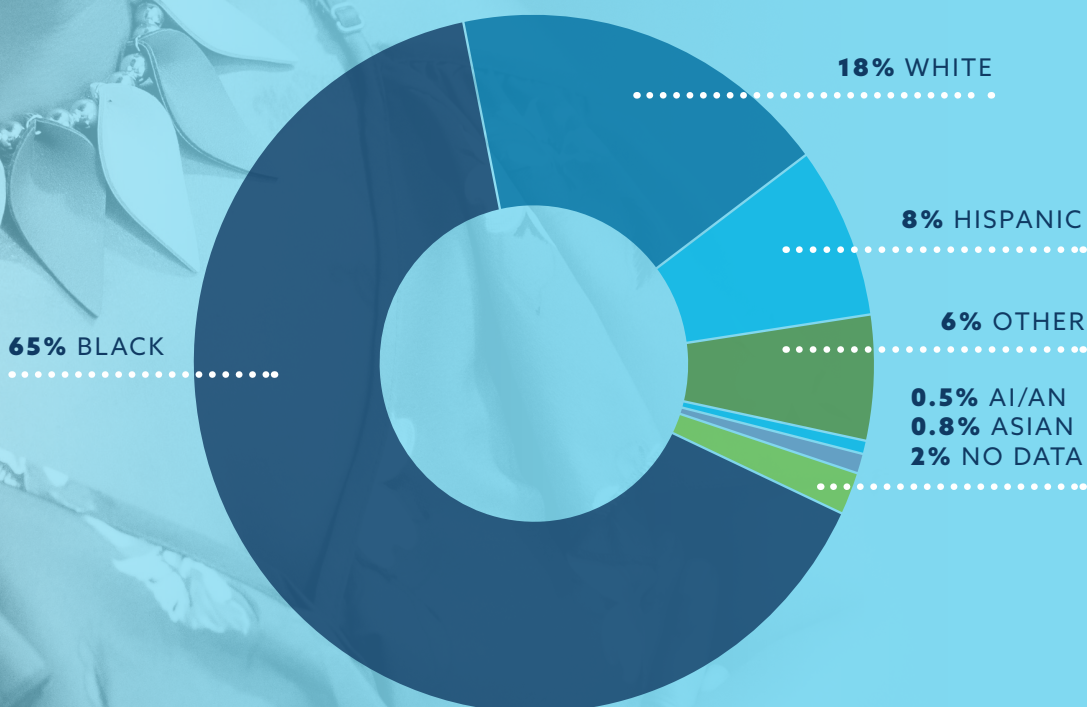

# Clinical Counseling

Center for Transforming Lives' clinical counseling services are dedicated to the emotional well-being of women, children, and families through a person-centered approach to process trauma and manage the daily stressors of life. Through the counseling program, women and their children are engaged with our licensed therapists who provide evidence-based, trauma-informed individual and family therapy. These assessment and evidence-based therapy services seek to improve participants' home, education, and employment environments by reducing the emotional and behavioral impact of trauma. CTL dedicates a team of licensed therapists working in tandem to simultaneously provide individual and family therapy to both generations of the family unit. This two-generational approach to clinical counseling focuses on supporting the whole family, strengthening relationships, and improving outcomes for women and their children.

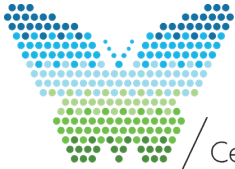

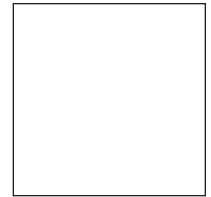
