



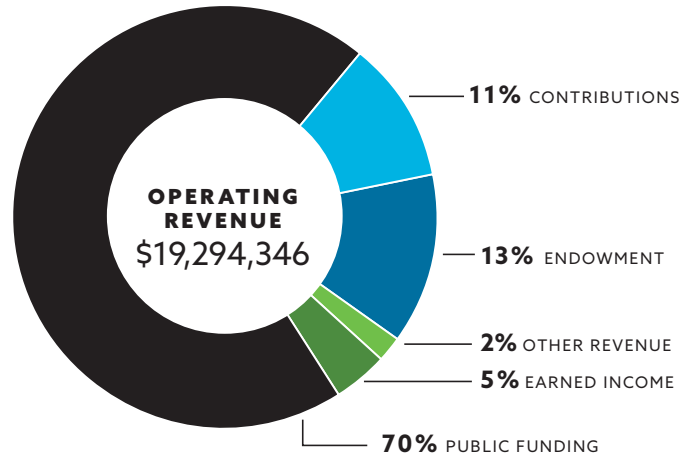
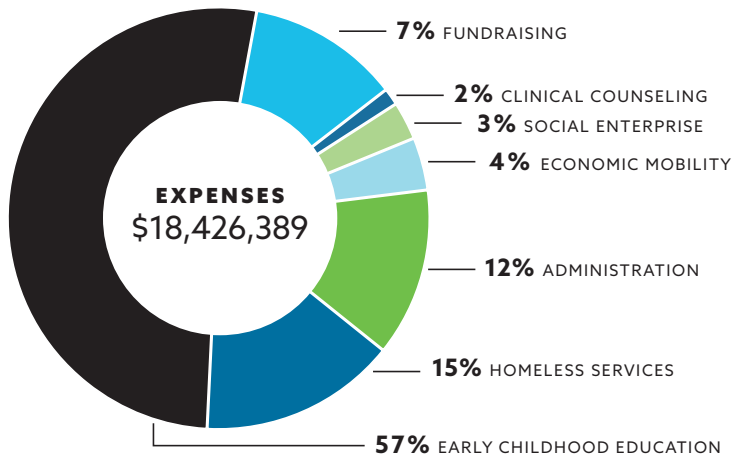

Mission Statement

The Center for Transforming Lives works side-by-side with women and their children throughout Tarrant County to disrupt the cycle of poverty by providing comprehensive homeless services, early childhood education, economic mobility services, and clinical counseling.

PROGRAMS



HOMELESS SERVICES

Center for Transforming Lives moves women and their children quickly off the streets and out of shelters into on-site and community-based housing. Case managers provide an array of wrap-around services to create safety and long-term self-sufficiency, including rent assistance, employment and education support, and health care.



CLINICAL COUNSELING SERVICES

Center for Transforming Lives' Clinical Counseling Services are dedicated to the emotional well-being of women, children, and families through a person-centered approach to process trauma and manage the daily stressors of life. Through the counseling program, women and their children are treated by licensed therapists who provide evidence-based, trauma-informed individual and family therapy.



EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

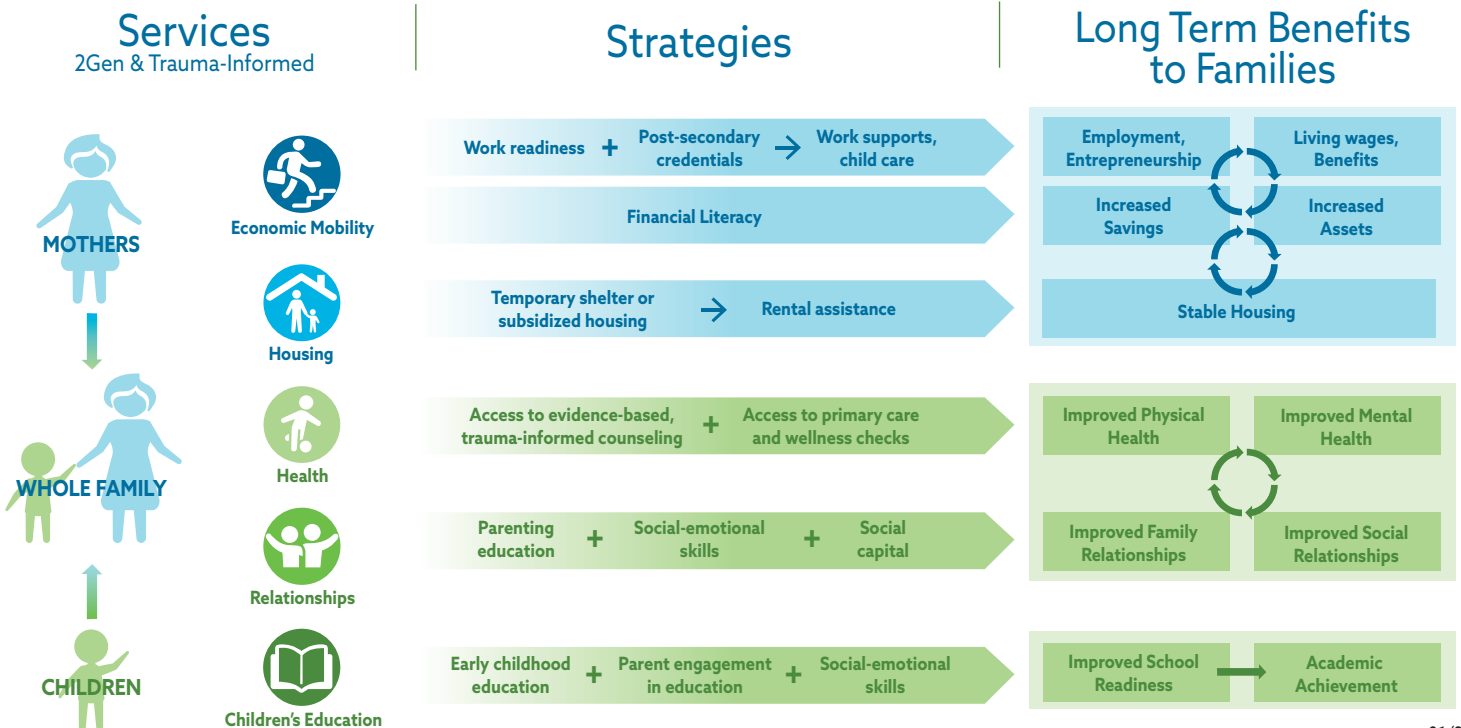
Center for Transforming Lives provides high-quality, affordable, year-round education at four child development centers and partners with other childcare centers throughout Tarrant County. As a Head Start and Early Head Start provider, Center for Transforming Lives is able to extend the reach to serve even more children and families living in poverty.



ECONOMIC MOBILITY

Center for Transforming Lives' economic mobility services work to disrupt the cycle of poverty by engaging women in asset-building services so they can create long-term financial independence and stability for themselves and their families. The program equips participants to increase income, savings and credit score, decrease debt, and operate a positive budget.
