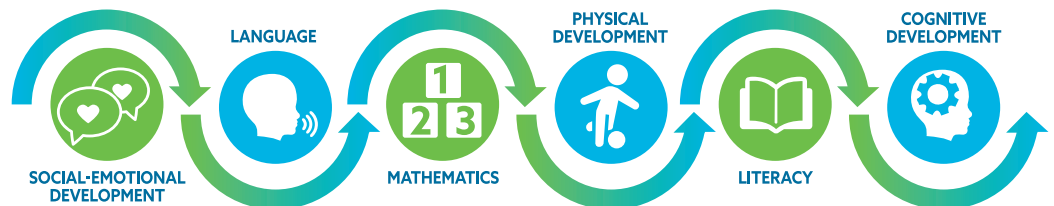

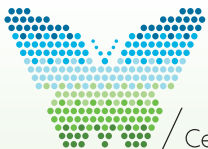

The program provides literacy-rich, child-centered classrooms with low child-to-teacher ratios, individualized care, healthy daily meals, ample outdoor time, and social strengthening activities.

Our Early Childhood Education Approach



Our dedicated teachers help children develop the social-emotional, cognitive, physical, and language skills they need for a successful transition to pre-kindergarten and kindergarten. Because young children need nurturing, low-stress environments filled with language, learning, physical activity, and positive social interactions, all ECE classrooms are child-centered, with one-on-one attention and support given to each child.
