Homeless Services





Last year, more than 234 women experiencing homelessness, most with children, turned to Center for Transforming Lives for refuge from their desperate, and all too often, violent situations. 92% of homeless mothers have experienced physical and/or sexual abuse. The unfortunate truth is that a significant gap exists between victim-specific services and our community's need. Simply put, there are few safe places victimized women with children can stay to begin the healing process. Without safety and stability, untreated trauma can have a life-long impact on physical and emotional health of children.

\$20,000 per year to care for a one family living in homelessness. When we support women and children moving from poverty to prosperity, we are working toward a better Tarrant County.

Center for Transforming Lives' homeless services provides women and their children with safe housing and comprehensive support through three programs. Services include rapidly moving homeless families from shelters to homes and an emergency homeless shelter for single women, all within a housing-first framework. Along with safe housing, CTL provides trauma-informed care, clinical counseling, early childhood education, jobreadiness, and financial education. This long-term support builds self-sufficiency, along with emotional and financial wellbeing.
